1 Evaluation Report

In the following report, you will gain a short overview of the results from the evaluation of course "European Union Politics – contemporary research perspectives" given by Prof. Dr. Christian Rauh. For the survey, the customized SET.UP questionnaire was used. The lecturer was able to adjust the questionnaire regarding his/her learning methods and aims in advance.
